

AKHMIS Consumer Notice

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that each jurisdiction receiving funding from HUD have a Homeless Management Information System in place. Therefore, this Agency is required to participate in the Alaska Homeless Management Information System (AKHMIS), a computerized system that collects and stores basic information about clients receiving services from this Agency. The goal of the AKHMIS is to assist us in determining your needs and to provide a record for evaluating the services we are providing to you.

We only collect information that is needed to provide you services, and we do not use or disclose your information without written consent, except when required by our funder or by law, or for specific administrative or research purposes outlined in the AKHMIS Privacy Notice. By requesting and accepting services from this program, you are giving consent for us to enter at least some of your personal information into AKHMIS.

The collection and use of all personal information is guided by strict standards of confidentiality. A copy of the AKHMIS Privacy Notice is available upon request for your review.

You have the ability to share your personal information with other area Partner Agencies that participate in the AKHMIS by completing an AKHMIS Release of Information Client Consent Form. This will allow those Partner Agencies to work in a cooperative manner to provide you with efficient and effective services.
